


On-time Placement Performance




Country Diversification (Pax Mos Sending)



Market Environment

Market Trends and Forecasts

Since the government continues to promote significant language-learning scholarships (mainly English, but also Dutch or German), the overall mobility industry is heavily geared towards language skills. 90% of the school exchange market comprises of "gap year" students (recent graduates, aged 17.5 – 18.5). However, the outlook for exchanges (mostly TR) during high school is now favorable as the law has been adapted to allow accreditation of studies abroad during the school term. As for duration, the interest seems to grow for SM and TR programs at the expanse of YP.
