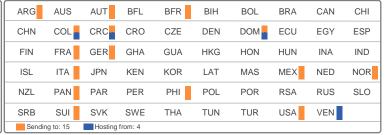
Updated Snapshot: Guatemala (GUA)

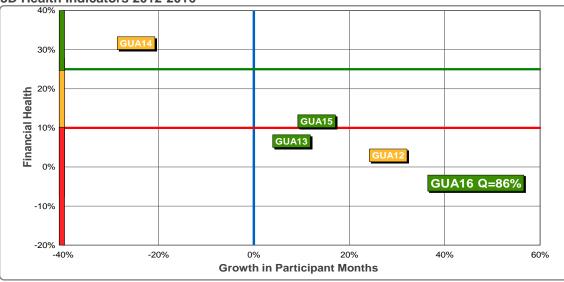
2016 was the year of growth in our sending numbers. The 40% growth is the result of the fulfillment of the action plan approved by the Board in 2014, when a leadership transition was made.

3D Health Indicators 2012-2016



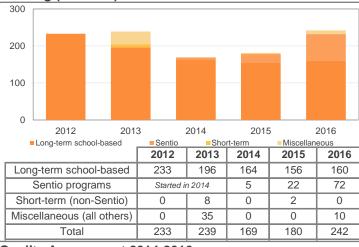

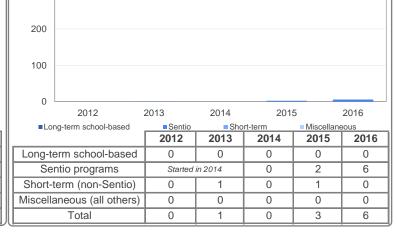

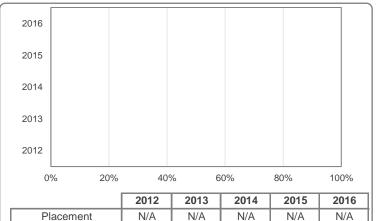

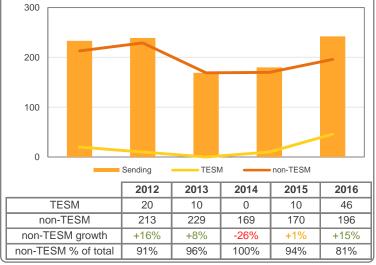

Country Diversification (Pax Mos Sending)

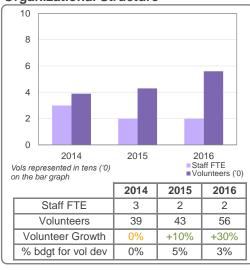


Organizational Structure

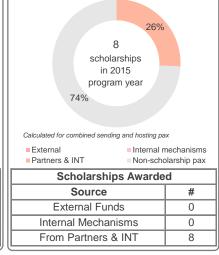
