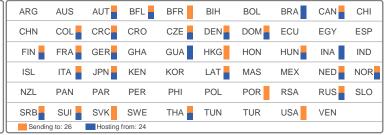

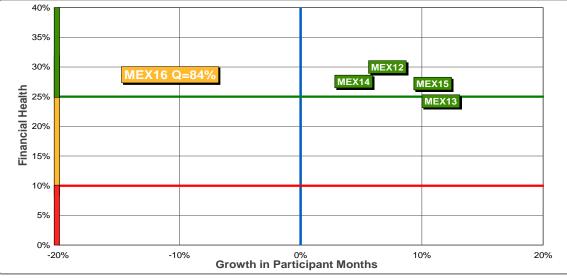
Statement

3D Health Indicators 2012-2016



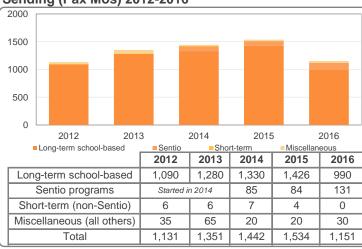

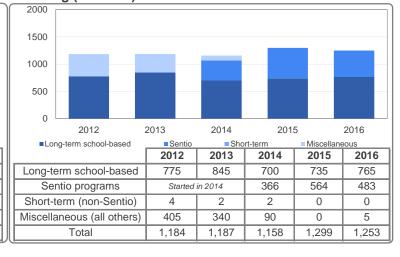

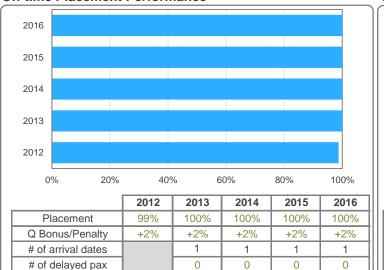

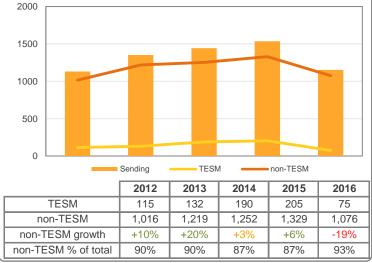

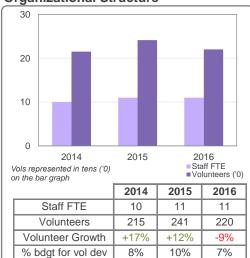
On-time Placement Performance



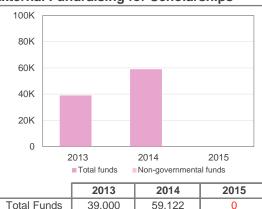
Country Diversification (Pax Mos Sending)



Organizational Structure

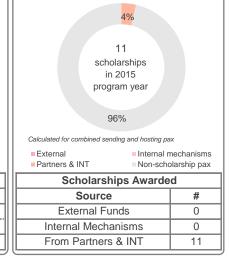
